03 Char Dham Yatra 2027 — Key Facts

04 The 10-Day Route by Public Transport

Here is a practical, day-wise itinerary that budget travellers have used successfully:

DAY 1

Rishikesh — The Gateway

Arrive, complete biometric registration at the Char Dham Registration Centre. Visit Triveni Ghat, Ram Jhula, and Laxman Jhula. Stay overnight and prepare for the journey ahead.

DAY 2

Rishikesh → Janki Chatti

Take the direct morning bus or travel via Dharasu Bend and Barkot. Aim to reach Janki Chatti before 4 PM to ensure comfortable lodging before the trek.

DAY 3

Yamunotri Darshan

Begin the 6 km trek to Yamunotri Temple at 5 AM. Complete darshan, soak in the natural hot springs, and return by noon. Proceed to **Uttarkashi** for the night.

DAY 4

Gangotri Darshan

Early bus or shared taxi to Gangotri. Visit the sacred temple on the banks of the Bhagirathi River — one of the most serene and spiritually powerful sites on the yatra. Return to Uttarkashi overnight.

DAY 5

Uttarkashi → Gaurikund

Travel via Ghansyali and Tilwara (note: no direct bus on this route — changes required). Stay at Gaurikund or nearby Sitapur to rest before the biggest trek of the journey.

DAY 6

Kedarnath Darshan ▲

Begin the challenging **16 km trek** early at dawn. Carry water, dry snacks, a raincoat, and a walking stick. Seek blessings at the sacred Kedarnath Temple and return to Sonprayag for the night.

DAY 7

Sonprayag → Badrinath

Direct buses available in the early morning. Alternatively, travel via Rudraprayag and Chamoli. The mountain scenery along this route is breathtaking.

DAY 8-

Badrinath Exploration

Visit Badrinath Temple, Tapt Kund, **Mana Village** (the last Indian village before Tibet), Vyas Gufa, Ganesh Gufa, Bhim Pul, and the Saraswati River. Give this magical place the time it truly deserves.

DAY 10

Badrinath → Haridwar — Return Journey

Morning bus to Haridwar via Joshimath, Chamoli, Rudraprayag, and Devprayag. Stay overnight in Haridwar, offer prayers at Har Ki Pauri ghat, and head home the next day carrying lifelong memories.

Key tip: Always reach your destination stop before 4 PM — hill buses stop running after that. Keep buffer days built in for weather-related delays, especially during monsoon months.

06 What to Buy at Each Dham

Shopping is a joyful part of the yatra, and each dham offers something beautifully unique:

G Gangotri

- ❖ Fresh mountain apples
- ❖ High-quality dry fruits from Himalayan orchards
- ❖ Sacred Ganga jal (holy water) in sealed bottles

K Kedarnath

- ❖ Sacred Rudraksha beads (5-mukhi and 1-mukhi)
- ❖ Shiva lingam stones from the Mandakini River
- ❖ Bhabhoot (sacred ash) from the temple

B Badrinath & Mana Village

- ❖ Van Tulsi garlands and Laddu Prasad
- ❖ Kuber Coins and rare herbal products
- ❖ Hing (asafoetida) – finest quality
- ❖ Handcrafted woolen shawls and socks from Mana
- ❖ Local herbal teas made by village artisans

Y Yamunotri

- ❖ Rice cooked in the natural hot springs (Yamunotri prasad)
- ❖ Potatoes boiled in the Surya Kund hot spring
- ❖ Yam ki Puja thali sets for worship
- ❖ Local herbal mountain remedies

07 Packing List — Travel Light, Trek Strong

Pack light – one backpack only. These are the essentials:

Clothing & Gear

- ❖ Thermal wear (top and bottom)
- ❖ Lightweight raincoat or poncho
- ❖ Woollen cap, gloves, and warm socks
- ❖ Sturdy trekking shoes or boots
- ❖ Walking / trekking stick

W Documents & Essentials

- ❖ Aadhaar card (original + photocopy)
- ❖ Printed Char Dham registration certificate
- ❖ Cash – ATMs are rare near the dhams
- ❖ Power bank (fully charged)
- ❖ Water bottle and dry snacks
- ❖ Altitude sickness tablets and basic medicines

08 Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Can I complete the Char Dham Yatra entirely by public transport?

Yes! Government buses and shared taxis connect all four dhams. You need patience and flexibility, but thousands of budget pilgrims do it every year. Just reach each stop before 4 PM and keep buffer days for weather delays.

Q2. What are the expected Char Dham Yatra 2027 opening dates?

Official dates will be announced on Basant Panchami (Jan/Feb 2027). Yamunotri, Gangotri, and Badrinath are expected to open in late April 2027. Kedarnath opens 5–7 days later due to snowfall at higher altitudes. Temples close after Diwali in October or November.

Q3. How much does the Char Dham Yatra cost by public transport?

Total cost ranges from ₹11,000 to ₹27,000 per person. Bus fares cost ₹3,000–₹5,000, accommodation ₹3,000–₹5,000, and food ₹2,000–₹3,000. Much cheaper than private taxis (₹25,000–₹50,000) or helicopters (₹1.8 lakh+).

Q4. Is registration mandatory for Char Dham Yatra 2027?

Yes, it is compulsory. Register at registrationandtouristcare.uk.gov.in, on the Tourist Care Uttarakhand app, or WhatsApp "Yatra" to +91-8394833833. Offline counters are available in Haridwar and Rishikesh. Always carry your registration certificate.

Q5. What is the best time to visit Char Dham without crowds?

Avoid May and June (peak season). Visit in the last two weeks of September or first two weeks of October for peaceful darshan, shorter queues, and stunning Himalayan scenery. Late June to early July also works if the monsoon is light.

Q6. Which bus route should I follow for Char Dham?

Follow this order: Rishikesh → Janki Chatti → Uttarkashi → Gaurikund → Badrinath → Haridwar. There is no direct bus from Uttarkashi to Gaurikund — change at Ghansyali and Tilwara. Always reach your stop before 4 PM, as hill buses stop running after that.

Q7. Is Char Dham Yatra by public transport safe for solo travellers?

Yes, for fit and experienced travellers. Register on the government portal for real-time alerts. Carry cash, as ATMs are rare near the dhams. Use BSNL or Jio for best network coverage. Always inform someone at home about your daily itinerary. Families and older pilgrims should consider a trusted tour operator.
